CULTIVATING GRATITUDE

Finding contentment through practicing gratitude means getting your eyes and heart off what is weighing you down and focusing on all the ways you have been supported and uplifted.




Become a Mall Walker

- » Safety. Walking through the mall means not having to contend with busy intersections, bicycles on the sidewalk, or dogs off their leashes.
