TAKE CONTROL OF YOUR WORKDAY

Expectations at work vary from person to person. There are projects to complete and deadlines to meet, but how you plan your time is often up to you. How can you master the art of time management?

- » The to-do list. We've all been there, with a whirlwind of tasks spinning in our minds. But dumping them onto a list and hoping to breeze through all of them is wishful thinking. One effective strategy is the 1-3-5 rule, in which you pick one big task, three medium ones, and five small ones to conquer in a day.
- » **Stop multitasking**. Focus on one task at a time rather than trying to do multiple things simultaneously. This way, you can give your full attention to each task and complete them more efficiently. Interruptions, even when self-imposed, make it difficult to regain focus. Avoid undermining your productivity with unnecessary distractions.
- » Consider your workspace. As much as you are allowed, spend time curating a workspace that encourages focus and keeps you motivated. For example, acquire an ergonomic chair or put your desk near a window. Add a plant or a piece

- of art you enjoy to your work area. Also, consider how you are slowed down by inefficient file management, poorly designed templates, or lost passwords. Not having a handle on these daily-use systems is a hurdle in your day that can be avoided.
- » Manage your energy. Everyone has peak times of performance during a given day. If you're unsure when yours are, consider keeping a journal for two weeks detailing when you felt most alert and productive each day and when you felt drained. Look for patterns in your energy levels, and plan your complex or creative work for your more productive times of day and the mundane tasks for those times when you feel less motivated. ❖


